Free to use cash machine installed at The Better Food Company store

The campaign for a free-to-use cash machine in the area was supported by <u>Stephen Williams, MP for Bristol West</u>, who commented: "A high proportion of St Werburghs' 2,500 residents are under significant financial pressures, so it is important that charges at cash machines are not another burden. We are currently under-served locally by retail banks so I really welcome PayPoint's action in installing this ATM here at The Better Food Company. I'm confident it will help local residents as paying to use a cash machine will no longer be a concern for people living in the area."
